FROM John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK)

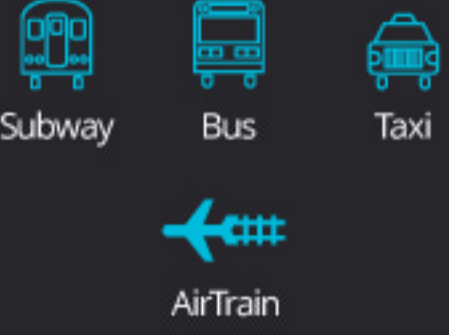
Located: Queens, NY

1 million passengers



JFK, New York's largest airport, attracted over 49 million passengers in 2012 thanks to its proximity to Manhattan and range of international and domestic flight options.

Transport options:



FROM Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR)

Located: Newark, NJ



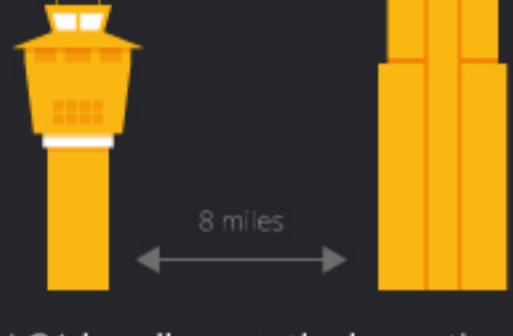
EWR operates thousands of flights out of its three major terminals and provides passengers many options for New York area transit.

Transport options:



FROM LaGuardia Airport (LGA)

Located: Queens, NY



LGA handles mostly domestic flights and is just 8 short miles from Midtown Manhattan.

Transport options:



Best itinerary to Lower Manhattan

Catch the **AirTrain** from your airport terminal to the **Howard Beach/JFK Airport Train Station** stop (9 mins)
Transfer to the **Northbound A Train** and head to Lower Manhattan (54 mins)

Total trip time: 63 minutes



Total cost: \$7.50



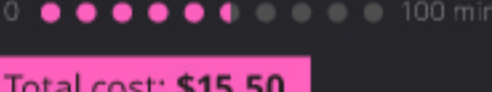
Other common options:

Taxi: \$52

Long Island Rail Road: \$7.50 and up

Catch a taxi to **Newark Penn Station** (8 mins)
Hop on the **Manhattan-bound PATH** line and voilà! You're in Lower Manhattan! (47 mins)

Total trip time: 55 minutes



Total cost: \$15.50



Other common options:

Taxi: \$57.50

Hop on the **Q70 Bus** from the airport to **Roosevelt Ave/74th St** (11 mins)
Transfer to the **E Train** to Lower Manhattan (31 mins)

Total trip time: 42 minutes



Total cost: \$2.50



Other common options:

Taxi: \$31

Best itinerary to Upper Manhattan

Catch the **AirTrain** from your airport terminal to the **Jamaica Train Station** stop (7 mins)
Transfer to the **Long Island Rail Road (LIRR)** and get off at **Penn Station** (31 mins)
Hop on the **3 Train** from **Penn Station** and head to Upper Manhattan (17 mins)

Total trip time: 55 minutes



Total cost: \$14.50



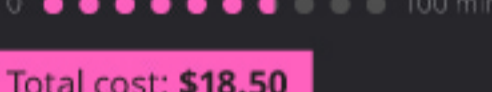
Other common options:

Instead of taking the Long Island Rail Road to Penn Station, jump on the **E Train** train from the Jamaica train station straight to Upper Manhattan: **\$7.50**

Taxi: \$52

Catch the **AirTrain** from your airport terminal to the **Newark Liberty Airport Station** (7-11 mins)
Take the **Newark Airport Express Bus** to **Port Authority** (40 mins)
Transfer to the **Harlem-bound 3 Train** on **42nd Street** and get off in Upper Manhattan (18 mins)

Total trip time: 65-69 minutes



Total cost: \$18.50



Other common options:

The **Newark Airport Express Bus** will transport you straight from the airport to **42nd Street** in Manhattan where you can easily transfer to the **2 Train** and go to Upper Manhattan: **\$18.50**

Taxi: \$77.50

If necessary, take the **Q72 Bus** from your terminal to the **LaGuardia International Roadway/Central Passenger Terminal** (8 mins)
Transfer to the **M60 Bus** heading to **West Side Broadway** and get off in Upper Manhattan (37 mins)

Total trip time: 45 minutes



Total cost: \$2.50



Other common options:

You can also hop on the **Q33 Bus** to **82nd Street/Astoria Blvd** and transfer to the **M60** from there: **\$2.50**

Taxi: \$26.40

Best itinerary to Brooklyn

Catch the **AirTrain** from your airport terminal to the **Howard Beach/JFK Airport Train Station** stop (9 mins)
Transfer to the **Northbound A Train** and head to Brooklyn (33 mins)

Total trip time: 42 minutes



Total cost: \$7.50



Other common options:

Forego taking a train altogether and hop on the **B15 Bus** from the airport to Brooklyn: **\$2.50**

Taxi: \$60-65

Catch the **AirTrain** from your airport terminal to the **Newark Liberty Airport Station** (7-11 mins)
Take the **Newark Airport Express Bus** to **Port Authority** (40 mins)
Transfer to the **2 Train** on **42nd Street** and head to Brooklyn (13 mins)

Total trip time: 60-64 minutes



Total cost: \$18.50



Other common options:

The **5 Train** on **42nd Street** will also take you to Brooklyn: **\$18.50**

Taxi: \$78.50

Hop on the **Q70 Bus** from the airport to **Roosevelt Ave/74th St** (17 mins)
Transfer to the **Coney Island-bound F Train** at the **Jackson Heights Station** (13 mins)
Get off at **Lexington Avenue** and transfer to the **Brooklyn-bound 4 Train** (33 mins)

Total trip time: 63 minutes



Total cost: \$2.50



Other common options:

After getting off at Lexington Avenue, you can also take the **Brooklyn-bound 5 Train**: **\$2.50**

Taxi: \$49.20

*Fares and travel times subject to change depending on time of day

INSIDER TIPS

For overnight arrivals: Trains, buses, and taxis run regularly, but after peak hours transport schedules may change, so be aware.

For taxi lovers: Some unscrupulous NYC taxi drivers have been known to rip-off passengers in various fare meters at higher rates than they should. If you think you've been cheated, call 311 to report the driver and get your money back.

For those traveling with lots of kids: Children under 16 can ride the Newark Airport Express Bus free of charge.

For those traveling in a rush: Opt for train routes – they're almost always faster than taxis and shuttles because there's no traffic underground!

REFERENCE GUIDE

AirTrain: A mono-rail type service that quickly and easily transports airline passengers to and from different airport terminals.

PATH (Port Authority Trans-Hudson): A train line providing service between New York City and New Jersey.

Express Bus: Unlike local buses which make all stops, express buses only stop at specified crossroads.
