












Airport (LGA)



For overnight arrivals: Trains, buses, and taxis run regularly, but after

peak hours transport schedules may change, so be aware. For taxi lovers: Some unscrupulous NYC taxi drivers have been known to rip-off passengers by running fare meters at higher rates than they should. If you think you've been cheated, call 311 to report the driver

For those traveling with lots of kids: Children under 16 can ride the Newark Airport Express Bus free of charge.

For those traveling in a rush: Opt for train routes – they're almost always faster than taxis and shuttles because there's no traffic underground!


